

The Tasha Hood

Created for my friend Tasha, who claims she "will rock wearing it in Aspen this winter."

Materials

- 4 skeins Debbie Bliss Como
- Size 15 24" circular needle
- Cable needle
- 2 markers

Gauge

10 sts = 4" in stockinette



Abbreviations

C6: Slip 3 sts to cable needle, hold at back, K3, then K3 from cable needle

C4: Slip 2 sts to cable needle, hold at back, K2, then K2 from cable needle

Instructions

Cast on 108 sts. Join in round and place marker.

Rnd 1: (P12 K6) 6 times

Rnd 2: (P5 P2tog P5 K6) 6 times

Rnd 3: (P11 K6) 6 times

Rnd 4: (P4 P2tog P5 K6) 6 times

Rnd 5: (P10 K6) 6 times

Rnd 6: (P4 P2tog P4 K6) 6 times

Rnd 7: (P9 K6) 6 times

Rnd 8 (cable row): (P3 P2tog P4 C6) 6 times

Rnd 9: (P8 K6) 6 times

Rnd 10: (P3 P2tog P3 K6) 6 times

Rnd 11: (P7 K6) 6 times

Rnd 12: (P2 P2tog P3 K6) 6 times

Rnd 13: (P6 K6) 6 times

Rnd 14: (P2 P2tog P2 K6) 6 times

Rnd 15: (P5 K2tog K2 K2tog) 6 times

Rnd 16 (cable row): (P1 P2tog P2 C4) 6 times

Rnd 17: (P4 K4) 6 times

Rnd 18: (P1 P2tog P1 K4) 6 times

Rnd 19: (P3 K4) 6 times

Rnd 20: (P1 P2tog K4) 6 times

Rnd 21: (P2 K4) 6 times

Rnd 22 (cable row): (P2 C4) 6 times

Rnd 23: (P2 K4) 6 times

Rnd 24: (P2 K4) 6 times

Now knit the hood. Note that the hood is knit flat (not in round):

Row 1: Knit across, increasing to 48 sts

Row 2: Turn work and (K1 P1) across

Continue working in pattern (Knit 1 row, K1P1 next row) for 6", ending with a K1P1 row.

Dec row: K21, SSK, place marker, k2, place marker, k2tog, knit to end of row

Next row: K1P1 across

Dec row: Knit to 2 sts before marker, SSK, slip marker, K2, slip marker, k2tog, knit to end

Next row: K1P1 across

Repeat last 2 rows until 24 sts remain

Fold hood in half and do a 3-needle bind off.

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
